From March 14 to July 23, 2023, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of ANR Pipeline Co.'s (ANR) procedures in Charleston, West Virginia, which was part of the construction inspected at ANR's Delhi Compressor Station. As a result of the inspection, ANR was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 19, 2024, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

ANR submitted its amended procedures on April 17, 2024. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
