RE: CPF 1-2024-029-NOA – NOTICE OF AMENDMENT – TC ENERGY RESPONSE

Mr. Burrough,

On April 16, 2024, TC Energy, on behalf of its subsidiary, Columbia Gas Transmission LLC, received CPF 1-2024-029-NOA – Notice of Amendment (Notice). On May 10, 2024, TC Energy submitted a 30-day request for extension which was granted the Pipeline and hazardous Material Administration on May 14, 2024. The extension has allowed TC Energy to submit our response on or by June 15, 2024. TC Energy has reviewed the Notice and is providing the following response:

The TC Energy *Storage Well Site Inspection Task Package (Item: 1014954671)* is being revised to address the allegations that were defined in the Notice. Task Package Section h was updated to require TC Energy's process for leak investigation, verification, response, and classification of a reported potential natural gas leaks. A redlined version of the task package is being provided in addition to the *Investigation and Verification of Natural Gas Leaks Procedure USGO (US) (Item: 009092490)*.

Upon acceptance from PHMSA the revised task package will be published in the TC Energy Controlled Document Library and made available all TC Energy employees. By taking these actions, TC Energy contends the requirements of the Notice have been satisfied and requests closure of this Notice.
