From April 1, 2024 through July 22, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals, LLC's (Kinder Morgan) breakout tank procedures. As a result of the inspection, Kinder Morgan was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 21, 2025, requiring Kinder Morgan to amend certain aspects of its procedures.

On June 19, 2025, Kinder Morgan submitted its amended procedures. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
