From February 27 through December 12, 2024, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC's (CGT) construction project at the Artemas Compressor Station and the related CGT construction procedures in Artemas, Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, CGT was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 1, 2025, which proposed amendment of your procedures

CGT submitted its amended procedures on July 30, 2025. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
