From December 4, 2023 to March 15, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) conducted an inspection of Collins Pipeline Company's (Collins Pipeline) control room procedures in Woodlands, Texas. On March 16, 2026, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Collins Pipeline's procedures.

Collins Pipeline submitted its amended procedures on May 15, 2026. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
