On March 17, 2026, PBF Energy Inc. received a Notice of Probable Violation, Docket CPF 1-2026-008-NOPV (NOPV) issued by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration related to a Collins Pipeline Company (CPC) control room management procedures and records audit it performed between December 4, 2023 to March 15, 2024.

It is CPC's intent to follow the *"Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Enforcement Proceedings"* under 49 CFR Part §190.208, *Procedure for Responding to a NOTICE OF PROBABLE VIOLATION, I(b), Option 1*. Without admission, PBF is not contesting the allegations and will take actions to comply with the proposed compliance order once a final order is issued.

In closing, CPC is committed to the safe operation of its pipeline system and continued improvement of its control room management procedures.
