From April 1 through December 2, 2024, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Tuscarora Gas Transmission Company's (Tuscarora) procedures in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, PHMSA issued Tuscarora was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on March 16, 2026, proposing modifications to your procedures.

Tuscarora responded with proposed amendments on April 14, 2026 and submitted its amended procedures on July 1, 2026. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures and determined that the inadequacies outlined in this NOA have been corrected.
