Dear Mr. Goodwin:

On July 29, 2011, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §60118(b) and 49 CFR §190.213, the Associate Administrator for Pipeline Safety, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued a Final Order to Gulf South Pipeline Company, L.P (Gulf South).

The Final Order found that Gulf South had committed a violation of the federal pipeline safety regulations and included a Compliance Order (CO), which required Gulf South to take certain actions to protect the public and the environment.

The PHMSA Southern Region has reviewed your letter of September 28, 2011, in response to the final order and CO. This case is now closed.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to CPF 2-2009-1001 and not to any other PHMSA pending cases. Also be advised that nothing herein states or implies that the Gulf South pipeline system meets the requirements of the federal pipeline safety laws or regulations. The pipeline system remains subject to inspection by PHMSA.
