On May 3, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site inspection of Georgia-Pacific Corporation's (Georgia-Pacific's) drug and alcohol (D&A) testing procedures in Atlanta, Georgia. As a result of the inspection, Georgia-Pacific was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 31, 2018, which proposed amendment of your D&A procedures.

Georgia-Pacific submitted its amended D&A procedures on June 26, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
