Dear Mr. Rowland:

Between February 26, 2018 and May 3, 2018, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) inspected Destin Pipeline Company, LLC's (Destin) records and procedures in Houston, Texas and Destin's records and pipeline facilities in Mississippi, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code. Third Coast, LLC (TC) is the parent company and majority owner of American Midstream, LLC (AMID) and Destin. As a result of the inspection PHMSA issued a Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order on February 5, 2020 and a Final Order on April 8, 2020.

TC submitted its responses from May 5, 2020 through February 9, 2022. PHMSA has reviewed TC's responses and determined that TC has complied with the terms of the Final Order.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the referenced case (**CPF 2-2019-1003**) and not to any other PHMSA cases, if any.
