On November 1 to November 4, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Enmark Energy procedures in Madison, MS. As a result of the inspection, Enmark Energy was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 28, 2023, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enmark Energy submitted its amended procedures on September 29, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Please be advised that this letter refers only to the referenced NOA (CPF #2-2023-012-NOA) and not to any other PHMSA cases, if any. Thank you for your cooperation.
