On December 5, 2024, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Superior Refining Company LLC, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.207, a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a requirement to pay the proposed civil penalty, with the referenced enforcement action closing upon receipt of payment and completion of the terms of the Compliance Order, as determined by the Southern Region Director.
