On February 7, 2024, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, LLC, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.233, a Corrective Action Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a requirement to take corrective actions on your pipeline. PHMSA issued an amended Corrective Action Order on February 9, 2024, amending certain of the corrective actions related to shutdown of the pipeline.
