On November 6 and 7, 2006, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Salmon Resources, Ltd. procedures in Marysville, Michigan.
