On June 14, 2012, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected TRU-GAS Inc.'s (TRU-Gas') procedures for Public Awareness Program Effectiveness in Waunakee, Wisconsin. As a result of the inspection, TRU-GAS was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 13, 2014, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
