On March 22-24 and May 3-5, 2016, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Statoil Oil & Gas LP (Statoil) procedures in Williston, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, Statoil was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 29, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Statoil submitted its amended procedures on March 28, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
