From November 14, 2016 and February 3, 2017, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Express Holdings (USA), LLC's procedures for Operator Qualification. As a result of the inspection, Endbridge was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 11, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Express Holdings (USA), LLC's submitted its amended procedures on February 12, 2019. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
