Dear Mr. Flota:

On September 3, 2020, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Administration (PHMSA) issued to Wolverine Pipe Line Company ("Wolverine") a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order was issued following a hearing on a Notice of Probable Violation and Civil Penalty. On September 28, 2020, Wolverine filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the Final Order requesting reconsideration of the findings of violation for Items 5 and 6, which Petition was denied on February 21, 2021. Thereafter, Wolverine filed a Petition for Review with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, which Petition was denied by the Court on June 2, 2023.

Based upon the above and foregoing and confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that Wolverine has complied with the terms of the Final Order.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
