On January 16, 2018 through July 20, 2018, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Enbridge Energy, LP procedures in Superior, Wisconsin. As a result of the inspection, Enbridge Energy, LP was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 20, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enbridge Energy, LP submitted its amended procedures on May 20, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
