From January 10, 2019 to June 21, 2019, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Spire Energy's (Spire), procedures in St. Louis, MO. As a result of the inspection, Spire was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 28, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Spire submitted its amended procedures on September 10 and November 10 of 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
