Express Holdings (USA), LLC (“Express”), a subsidiary of Enbridge Inc. (“Enbridge”), responds to the above-referenced Notice of Probable Violation (“NOPV”) issued by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (“PHMSA”). PHMSA granted Express an extension of time to December 2, 2020 to respond.

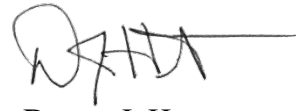
Consistent with Express’s discussions with the Region, Express requests execution of a Consent Agreement and Order under 40 CFR § 190.219, as follows:

- Item 1 will be reduced from NOPV to Warning.
- The Proposed Compliance Order will be modified to a Consent Order to remediate three (3) spans exposed to the atmosphere and coated with Fusion Bonded Epoxy (“FBE”). The three (3) spans are identified as 6-2003+72-4000, 1-7217+53-1690, and 6-5792+77-5430.
- Express agrees to complete the remediation work within twelve (12) months from the date of the Consent Agreement and Order, but reserves the right to request and obtain a reasonable extension of time to complete the remediation work based on circumstances beyond its control, such as, but not limited to, weather conditions and permitting delays.

Express appreciates PHMSA’s cooperation throughout this process.
