From June 10 through July 12, 2019, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of USG Wheatland Pipeline, LLC procedures in Williston, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, USG Wheatland Pipeline, LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 12, 2020, which proposed amendments of your procedures.

USG Wheatland Pipeline, LLC submitted its amended procedures on October 6, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
