From July 27 through August 24, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Exxon Mobil's procedures in Springs, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Exxon Mobil was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 8, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Exxon Mobil submitted its amended procedures on December 21, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
