From March 3, 2019 through September 27, 2019, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Kinder Morgan Utopia LLC's (Kinder Morgan) procedures for its pipeline facilities subject to 49 CFR Part 195. As a result of the inspection, Kinder Morgan was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 26, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Kinder Morgan submitted its amended procedures on April 27, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
