On March 23, April 26 to 29, May 10 to 12 and June 8 to 10, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Summit Midstream Partners, LLC (SMP) procedures virtually and in Epping, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, SMP was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 3, 2022 which proposed amendment of your procedures.

SMP submitted its amended procedures on March 4, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
