From July 19 to September 17, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) procedures in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada. As a result of the inspection, Control Room Management was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 7, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enbridge submitted its amended procedures on February 7, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
