From April 27 through 30, 2021, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Continental Resources, Inc.'s (Continental) procedures in Sydney, Montana. As a result of the inspection, Continental was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 1, 2022, which proposed amendments to its procedures.

Continental submitted its amended procedures August 31, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
