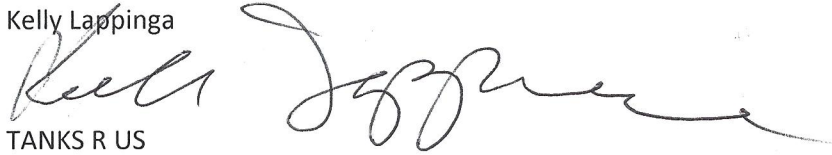
Mr. Ochs,

This letter is in response to the Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order received March 25, 2022. In relation to Probable Violation #1 concerning records documenting the pressure test of the tank, TRU has not been able to locate the records from the original pressure test. TRU will complete a pressure test on the tank within 2 years from the date of the final order. In compliance with the order, TRU will provide the following to the Director of PHMSA Central Region:

- At least 60 days prior to the test, submit a plan describing the requirements the tank will be tested to which will comply with current DOT standards for documentation, testing, and filling and dewatering.
- Within 90 days of test completion, a complete record demonstrating compliance for this pressure test that applies with the documentation requirements at the time of the test.

TRU has implemented a process of ensure annual review of the Operations and Maintenance Manual which was completed in March 2021 and February 2022.
