From June 14 to July 20, 2021 a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Plains Pipeline procedures in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Plains Pipeline was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 4, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Plains Pipeline submitted its amended procedures on April 1, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
