From May 17 to May 23, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Spire Missouri, Inc. East's (Spire) procedures in St Louis, Missouri. As a result of the inspection, Spire was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 25, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Spire submitted its amended procedures on August 14, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
