From May 24 to 28, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Navajo Nation Oil and Gas' (NNOG) procedures in Farmington, New Mexico. As a result of the inspection, NNOG was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 1, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

NNOG submitted its amended procedures on September 7, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
