On December 6-10, 2021, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected KPC Pipeline, LLC's procedures in Wichita, Kansas. As a result of the inspection, KPC Pipeline, LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 22, 2022, which proposed amendments to its procedures.

KPC Pipeline LLC submitted its response, and subsequent amended procedures, on July 13, 2022, October 2, 2022, and December 1, 2022. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
