From March 29, 2021 to February 1, 2022, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of TC Oil Pipeline Operations Inc.'s / TC Energy (TCE) procedures for Operation and Maintenance and Integrity Management.. As a result of the inspection, TCE was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 4, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

TCE submitted its amended procedures on December 2, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
