Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (“Magellan”) received a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) and Proposed Civil Penalty, CPF 3-2023-001-NOPV, on May 8, 2023. In accordance with *Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Enforcement Proceeding*, Magellan hereby requests an extension of time until July 21, 2023 to provide time to further discuss these Items and Proposed Civil Penalties with PHMSA.

Magellan requests a consultation and settlement conference with PHMSA Central Region as it believes that this matter can be fully resolved without a hearing. Magellan also respectfully reserves the right to a hearing in accordance with Option #4 in the *Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Enforcement Proceedings* should a resolution not be reached during the consultation and settlement conference with PHMSA.

Magellan appreciates the opportunity to respond and proactively work through the alleged violations with PHMSA in an effort to make the hearing unnecessary.
