On April 25 through April 29, May 2 through May 4, and May 9 through May 11, 2022, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an inspection of Caliber Spring Creek, LLC's ("Caliber") procedures for Control Room Management (CRM), SCADA, Leak Detection, and Operations and Maintenance (O&M) relevant to the control room located in Houston, Texas. On July 3, 2024, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Caliber's procedures.

Caliber submitted its amended procedures on October 18 and November 18, 2024 and provided supplements on November 21 and December 2, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
