From July 10 through July 14, 2023, representatives of the Michigan Public Service Commission, acting as an interstate agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected DTM Gas Storage Company's (DTM) procedures for operation and maintenance. As a result of the inspection, DTM was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 15, 2024, which proposed amendment of your procedures
