From July 26 to September 14, 2023, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), virtually inspected Alliance Pipeline L.P.'s (Alliance) procedures for Control Room Management (CRM) in Calgary, Alberta, Canada. On April 1, 2024, Enbridge sold the Alliance Pipeline to Pembina which included operations of the Control Room. As a result of the inspection, Alliance was issued a Notice of Amendment on June 3, 2024, which proposed amendment of Alliance's procedures.

Alliance submitted its amended procedures on November 1, 2024. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
