From August 28 to August 31, 2023, representatives of the Minnesota Office of Pipeline Safety, acting as an interstate agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Centra Pipeline Minnesota, Inc.'s (CPM) procedures for operation and maintenance. As a result of the inspection, CPM was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 16, 2024, which proposed amendment of your procedures
