From April 17 to May 17, 2023, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Marathon Pipeline LLC's (Marathon) procedures for Control Room Management in Findlay, Ohio. On September 26, 2024, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Marathon's procedures.

Marathon submitted its amended procedures on January 9, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
