On November 21, 2024, Texas Gas Transmission, LLC (TGT), a subsidiary of Boardwalk Pipelines, LP, was issued a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order for the case number referenced above. This Notice cited TGT for one instance of failing to take prompt remedial action to repair an emergency valve, per the requirements of 49 C.F.R. § 192.745(b).

Based on additional information submitted by Boardwalk in response to the Notice, this letter is to inform you that PHMSA hereby withdraws the Notice. This case is now closed.
