From August 21 through October 5, 2023, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an inspection of the procedures for operation and maintenance and integrity management of Texas Gas Transmission, LLC, and Gulf South Pipeline, LLC (BW Pipelines) in Owensboro, Kentucky. On August 15, 2025, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) in the above-referenced case. The Notice proposed amendment of BW Pipeline's procedures.

BW Pipelines submitted its amended procedures on February 20, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice have been corrected.
