From February 2, 2023, to February 14, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an inspection of Spire STL Pipeline, LLC's (Spire) operations and maintenance procedures for the Spire STL Pipeline, LLC in St. Louis, Missouri. On December 20, 2024, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Spire's procedures.

Spire submitted its amended procedures on January 19, 2025 and August 23, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
