From April 17 to May 17, 2023, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an inspection of Marathon Pipe Line, LLC's (Marathon) procedures and records in Findlay, Ohio. On June 16, 2025, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Marathon's procedures.

Marathon submitted its amended procedures on September 18 and December 5, 2025, and January 28, 2026. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
