From September 16 to September 19, 2024, representatives of the Minnesota Office of Pipeline Safety (MNOPS), acting as interstate agents for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected the procedures for integrity management and operator qualification of Central Pipeline Minnesota, Inc.(Centra) at the MNOPS offices in St. Paul, Minnesota. On May 5, 2025, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of Centra's procedures.

Centra submitted its amended procedures on June 3, 2025 and September 10, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
