From October 20 to November 10, 2024, representatives of the Michigan Public Service Commission, acting as an Interstate Agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an integrated inspection of DTE Gas Company's (DTE) procedures and natural gas facilities on the Vector Pipeline System in Detroit, Michigan. On May 20, 2025, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of DTE's procedures.

DTE submitted its amended procedures on June 13, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
