From August 5 through September 24, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected the plans and procedures for Control Room Management (CRM) of CountryMark Refining and Logistics, LLC (CountryMark) in Mount Vernon, Indiana.

On July 2, 2025, pursuant to 49 CFR § 190.206, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment which proposed amendment of CountryMark's plans and procedures.

CountryMark submitted its amended procedures on September 17, 2025. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
