During April 9-13, 2007; April 23-27, 2007; and May 7, 2007 representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Mustang Pipe Line LLC (Mustang) procedures for Hazardous Liquid Integrity Management in Houston, TX.

As a result of the inspection, Mustang was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 2, 2007.
