PETITION FOR REVIEW

Centurion Pipeline L.P., a subsidiary of Occidental Petroleum Corporation, ("Centurion") hereby petitions the Court for review of the Final Order dated March 31, 2017 and the Decision on Petition for Reconsideration dated October 24, 2017 of the U.S. Department of Transportation, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety ("PHMSA"). This petition is timely under 29 U.S.C. § 60119(a).

This petition arises from a Final Order entered on March 31, 2017, which found that Centurion committed two violations of the pipeline safety regulations and proposed a penalty and compliance order action items. Centurion

requested a hearing regarding the allegations, which was held on April 29, 2015. After the hearing, PHMSA issued a Final Order on March 31, 2017. Centurion submitted a Petition for Reconsideration on April 27, 2017. PHMSA denied the Petition for Reconsideration on October 24, 2017. The Decision on the Petition for Reconsideration states that it constitutes final agency action taken by PHMSA.

Venue is appropriate in this Court pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 60119(a)(1). Centurion's principal place of business is in Houston, Texas.
