Dear Mr. McIlwain:

On March 12, 2015, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to West Texas Gulf Pipeline Company (WTG) a Corrective Action Order (CAO). The CAO required WTG develop a restart plan, effect a pressure restriction on the affected segment, develop an integrity verification and remediation plan for the pipeline system, and implement mitigative actions necessary for the safe operation of the pipeline. An amendment to the CAO issued by PHMSA on September 4, 2015 reinstated an operating pressure restriction and directed WTG to complete additional remedial actions. The resulting Consent Order (CO), issued March 24, 2017, included requirements to apply corrective measures to improve the safety record of WTG.

WTG has completed all requirements of the CAO and CO. This letter is to inform you that no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case, and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
