During the period of May 2016 to October 2016, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected OkTex Pipeline Company, LLC (OkTex) procedures for Operations, Maintenance, and Emergency in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

As a result of the inspection, OkTex was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on April 10, 2017 which proposed amendment of your procedures.
